Templegate Training Academy C.I.C (TTA) is a non-profit making Community Interest Company and an independent learning provider. We deliver adult education programmes in our main site in Wolverhampton and also have delivery locations in Birmingham and Bristol. All our learners are adults (aged 18+), with the highest numbers enrolled on Functional Skills, Business Administration, Digital Enterprise and Adult Health Care programmes. TTA is funded by the Educational and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) to provide advanced learner loans and adult education budget programmes.

TTA's vision is to engage and help the local people through training and education and provide a lifelong learning experience. We value our communities and put people first where everybody feels included in an open, welcoming, safe and supportive environment. Our commitment to equality and diversity underpins everything we do.
